About Chennai

Chennai, the capital city of Tamil Nadu is sited on the Coromandel Coast of the Bay of Bengal. The earlier name of the city, Madras is believed to be originated from Madrasapattinam, a fishing village located north of the St. George Fort. It has played a very crucial role in the traditional, historical and academic growth of the country. Today, Chennai, the capital city is the 4th largest city of India and is also the leading commercial centre of South India. Chennai, being an important metropolitan city is very well-connected to all the major cities of India as well as with the countries overseas. And, it is also considered as the cultural hub of South India which is famous for its affluent heritage in classical dance, music, architecture, sculpture, crafts, etc. This city is renowned for Bharatnatyam, the famous and one of the oldest classical dance forms in India, which originated in Tamil Nadu. The Chennai Mofussil Bus Terminus (CBMT) at Koyambedu is the leading bus terminal in Asia. The Anna Centenary Library in the capital city of Tamil Nadu is the largest library in Asia. The Vandalur Zoo sited in Chennai was set up in 1855 and it is the first public zoo in India and also the largest one in the country. The Cancer Institute established in 1920 is one of the oldest cancer hospitals in India. Chennai is the second leading exporter of information technology (IT) and business process outsourcing (BPO) services in India.

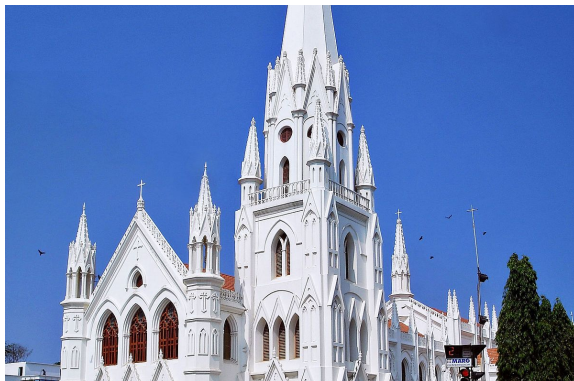
